## **Alternative Education Classroom Rules**

1. All students must adhere to the dress code: Pants pulled up, shirt tucked in, appropriate shoes and belt must be worn. Tights, sweat or nylon pants, pajamas, or sleeveless, low cut or short shirts are prohibited.
2. Hats, bandanas, headbands, dew rags, picks, or combs are prohibited.
3. Bulky coats or jackets are prohibited—lightweight sweaters or thin jackets are allowed at the teachers' discretion. Students must dress appropriately and it is the student's responsibility to dress to stay cool or warm while in class.
4. Electronic equipment of any kind is prohibited in the classroom. Any items that are brought in should be turned into the staff during morning exercises and these personal items will be locked away in a bag with the students name on it. The items will be returned at dismissal time.
5. Use of profanity, inappropriate language or slang is prohibited. Proper manners are expected at all times.
6. Good personal hygiene should be practiced daily.
7. Sleeping, rocking in chairs, drawing on desks, walls or books are prohibited.
8. Students are expected to have paper and pencil each day.
9. Backpacks and large bags are prohibited. Students may bring backpacks and book bags the first days to bring their materials. Purses must be hung up on a hook or given to the staff to be locked away.
10. Food and drink are allowed only during lunch or at the teachers' discretion. Lunches should not contain pop-top metal cans (e.g. sardines) or metal cutlery.
11. Students are not permitted to leave their chair or desk at anytime without the permission of the teacher.

12. The Northern Neck Technical Center Career and Technology area is not part of the Alternative Program area. Students are prohibited from that area unless accompanied by a teacher.
13. Alternative Education students do not have the right to vending machines, soda machines, or outside privileges such as assemblies.
