Purpose:

The Northern Neck Technical Center Foundation, Inc. Scholarship was established under the authority of The Northern Neck Technical Center's Advisory Council to provide financial assistance to students who complete programs at The Northern Neck Technical Center and have a desire to continue their education. Foundation Board members will review all applications. Students will be notified of the status of their application prior to the end of the 2009-2010 school year.

Criteria:

1. Student must be a graduating senior or GED recipient.
2. Student must complete his/her course at The Northern Neck Technical Center and be recommended by his/her instructor.
3. Student must have an A or B average in his/her course at The Northern Neck Technical Center and be active in Technical Center activities. (There is no requirement for minimum grades at home high school but transcripts will be reviewed.)
4. Student must be enrolled as a full-time student at the college or technical school he/she is attending. Scholarship funds are for the next school year only and can not be put "on hold" if student decides not to attend school in 2010-2011. If student is approved for a scholarship this year, he/she can re-apply for a Northern Neck Technical Center Foundation, Inc. Continuing Scholarship each year while pursuing an undergraduate degree. Applications for Continuing Scholarships can be requested in future years by contacting the Guidance Counselor.
5. Application with two letters of recommendation (one from Technical Center instructor) and unofficial (unsealed) transcript of grades from home high school must be submitted to the Guidance Office by Friday, April 23, 2010. Do not include a recommendation from a family member.
6. Scholarship funds will be released directly to the college or technical school when we receive a copy of student's registration and class schedule. It is the student's responsibility to ask for this information; a letter with all details will be mailed in June.
7. Although not required for scholarship consideration, students are strongly encouraged to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to explore those options meant for financial assistance to college or technical school. Students are also encouraged to apply for other scholarships for which they may be eligible.
